GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

- 1. The management reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and to correct any error or make any alterations that may be necessary in the prize list. EC rules and regulations will be followed.
- 2. The management reserves the right to cancel or combine any class not filled to satisfaction; whereupon exhibitors will be notified as soon as possible after close of entries.
- 3. Unsportsmanlike behavior/ inhumane treatment of a horse will not be tolerated. Kickers are to be flagged. Furthermore, the show steward has the right to check any tack concerns (i.e.: tight nosebands), disqualify any lame or injured horse from competition, and report any mistreatment of a horse to AEF Officials at their discretion. Violation of this rule, at the discretion of the organization committee, will result in disqualification and forfeiture of fees.
- 4. Any exhibitor using a wrong number, or having no number, may be excused or disqualified from the class, at the judge's discretion.
- 5. Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, handler or rider, will disqualify the horse, and result in forfeiture of entry fees for subsequent classes. Management reserves the right to remove a groom, handler/rider and/or horse from the show, without being liable for compensation.
- 6. No judge shall be approached with regard to any decision during the time he is judging or is about to judge. Penalty will be disqualification from the show in its entirety.
- 7. The medical aid fee covers the cost of the medical aid on site. The fee does not cover personal expenses incurred by the injured party in the event of an injury or transportation by ambulance. Any injury or medical expenses incurred while on Shadowlands Ranch property are the sole responsibility of the injured party, including any transportation by ambulance.
- 8. No person other than officials, staff on duty, and the judges of the classes may enter the competition rings without permission of the tournament management. Competitors are allowed in the competition rings only when competing, when the course is open for walking or during scheduled schooling rounds.
- 9. Do not ride or graze your horse on the lawn. No dogs allowed.
- 10. NO SMOKING on the property!!
- 11. Horses must be attended at all times. Special requests should be noted on the entry form and will be accommodated at the discretion of Shadowlands Ranch.
- 12. The trailer parking area must be kept clean at all times and all alleys between unobstructed. Parking will be assigned to you.
- 13. No Stallions other than in hand class
- 14. Please deposit all manure and unused hay in the appropriate manure pile.
- 15. <u>HELMETS are mandatory for anyone under 18 And strongly recommended for adults</u>. Helmets must be ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) or BSI approved helmets, with safety harness correctly fashioned, at all times while mounted on the property. It is understood that juniors not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete at these competitions.
- 16. Front and hind jump boots, bell boots, bitless bridles, and martingales (excluding German), are allowed in all jumping classes.
- 17. There is no enforced show attire, however light-coloured breeches and collared shirts (short or long sleeve) are encouraged. Field boots or half chaps are acceptable. Show jackets are not required.
- 18. In the event of a fall or two refusals, the rider may take one courtesy jump, that they have already jumped, before leaving the show arena.
- 19. In the event of rain or severe weather the show may be postponed or canceled at the discretion of management.

- 20. Ribbons will be awarded to 5th place.
- 21. Cancellation Policy: Cancellations prior to May 17th deadline will be refunded for all classes, no admin fee refunds. Cancellations after May 17th deadline will not receive a refund.
- 22. On-site medic arrives at 8:00 am for facility orientation. No one is allowed to be mounted until 8:15 am. Failing to follow this rule will result in immediate disqualification from the show with no refund.
- 23. No lunging allowed in the indoor arena.

Class Descriptions and Rules

Keyhole	Ride into the keyhole, turn around and ride out without crossing the line of the keyhole. Disqualification if you cross the line. Class is based on a clean run, fastest time.
Pole Bending	Rider must walk/trot/lope weaving through poles, turn, weave back through the poles and ride to the finish line. Fastest clean time wins.
Barrels	Rider must complete the barrel pattern with no barrels knocked over. Fastest time wins.
Stakes Race	2 stakes are set 100ft apart. Start/finish line is drawn in the middle. Figure 8 pattern
	ridden around the stakes. Right or left start is allowed.
Egg and Spoon	Contestants balance an egg on a spoon while mounted. Riders must walk/trot/canter/halt
Race	at the judge's call. Last person with their egg still on the spoon wins!
Bareback \$5 Bill	Contestants must ride bareback with a \$5 bill (provided by the contestant) placed under
	their thigh. Contestants compete at the walk/trot/canter/halt. Last person with their bill still underneath them takes all cash!

2. Divisions

Division A: X-Poles

Jumps not to exceed 18". Open to any horse/ rider combination that has not previously shown above 2'3.

Division B: 2'

Open to any horse/rider combination that has not previously shown above 2'6.

Division C: 2'3

Open to any horse/ rider combination that has not previously shown above 2'9. Can include oxers, fill and combinations. **Division D: 2'6**

Open to any horse/ rider combination that has not previously shown above 3'. Can include oxers, fill and combinations. **Division E: 2'9**

Open to any horse/ rider combination that has not previously shown above 3'3. Can include oxers, fill and combinations. **Division F: 3'**

Open to any horse/rider combination that has not previously shown above 3'6. Can include oxers, fill and combinations.

3. Ribbons & Prizes - In the result of a tie for champion, a coin toss will be completed.

- Clear round ribbons are presented for clear round classes.
- 1st 5th ribbons are presented for optimum time, speed & Jump off.
- A "Division Champion Ribbon" will be presented for each height.
- A clear round ribbon will earn you 1 point
- 1st ribbon= 7 points
- 2nd ribbon= 5 points
- 3rd ribbon= 4 points
- 4th ribbon= 3 points
- 5th ribbon= 2 points

4. Class Descriptions and Rules

Poles on the ground	All ages but ONLY suitable for walk/trot riders not ready or comfortable jumping.
Clear round	A shortened, introductory course to help get horses/riders comfortable on course. Not to exceed 8 fences. Ribbon awarded to a no fault round.
Optimum time	Complete a clean course, based on time with no faults.
Speed	Fastest clear round wins.
Jump off	If you have clear rounds in all classes you move onto a 5 fence jump off.

Class times will depend on the number of entries. Management reserves the right to run classes earlier or later than scheduled above.

An additional break to harrow the arena will be conducted if necessary, depending on the number of entries participating. Please note the 3 available times for course walks ONLY.
